

AMERICAN DISPOSAL RECYCLING SERVICES

Accepted Materials

The following items should be collected un-bagged and in your bin. There is no need to collect your recyclables using plastic bags. This makes it harder to process. Recyclables should also be clean and empty. Drips that remain at the bottom of a soda are OK. A half-full can of soda is not OK to place in your bin.

- **Containers:** Jugs, bottles, cartons, tubs, trays, buckets, bins
- **Cans:** Aluminum, Steel, Aerosol
- **Cardboard:** Shipping/Moving (flattened), Cereal, Paperboard, Frozen food
- **Paper:** Office, magazines, newspaper, books, mail, shredded (bagged)

Unaccepted Materials

The following materials should never be placed in your recycling bin for collection:

- **Plastic bags**
- **Phones/electronics**
- **Diapers**
- **Food**
- **Plastic foam**
- **Clothes**
- **Cables/lights**
- **Wrappers**

Cardboard Collection

A maximum of 30 boxes can be collected with your normal recycling service schedule. Boxes must be broken down and flat (preferably bundled and tied) before placing curbside. Should you need more than 30 boxes collected, a special pick up request will need to be submitted.
